CHAPTER 352.

AN ACT to provide copies of Sanborn and Berryman's annotated statutes to persons therein named, and making an appropriation therefor.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The superintendent of public property is directed to procure and deliver one copy of Sanborn and Berryman's annotated statutes to the assistant chief clerks, bookkeepers and clerks of the judiciary committees of each house, and one copy thereof to each of the following named members of the legislature, viz.: Assemblymen Longbotham, Henderson, Houston, Plummer, Eno, Textor, Davenport, Munger, Winans, Nolan, Dawson, Lusher and Louis Rossman.

Sanborn & Berryman's Annotated Statutes to be purchased.

SECTION 2. A sum sufficient to carry out the provisions of this act is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated.

CHAPTER 353.

AN ACT to authorize the commissioners of public lands to loan the county of Dunn a sum of money from the trust funds of the state and to repeal chapter 314, of the general laws of 1889.
