CHAPTER 355.

AN ACT to change the time for holding terms of court in Brown county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1, of chapter 82, of the laws of 1887, is hereby amended by striking out the word "fourth" before the word "Monday" in the tenth line of said section, and inserting in lieu thereof the word "last," so that said section when amended shall read as follows: Section 1. The general terms of the circuit court for the fourteenth judicial circuit shall be held as follows: In the county of Door, the first Tuesday in February and the Tuesday after the first Monday in September; in the county of Marinette, the first Monday of October, the second Monday of January and the first Monday of May; in the county of Oconto, the second Monday of April and the second Monday of November; in the county of Brown, the last Monday of November, the first Monday of March and the first Monday of June. Every term in the counties of Brown, Oconto and Marinette shall also be a special term for the whole judicial circuit.
