## CHAPTER 368.

AN ACT allowing county boards to allow a certain amount to county superintendents for traveling expenses.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. The county board of supervisors of each county in this state may allow the county superintendent of schools such sum over and above his salary as superintendent, as he shall certify that he has actually expended in defraying his traveling expenses when engaged in his official duties; provided, such reimbursement shall not exceed two hundred dollars in any one year, such expenses to be computed from and after April 1, 1891, and shall be audited and allowed by the county board of supervisors at its annual meeting in November of each year.

Traveling expenses for county superintendents.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication. Approved April 22, 1891.
