CHAPTER 421.

AN ACT to extend the benefits of chapter 304, of the general laws of 1887 to indigent parents of deceased union soldiers, sailors and mariners.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The relief granted by chapter 304 of the general laws of 1887 to indigent union soldiers, sailors and mariners, and their wives, widows and minor children is hereby extended to indigent parents of such soldiers, sailors and mariners when such soldiers, sailors or mariners died without leaving widows or children entitled to relief under said chapter and the laws amendatory thereof.

Relief extended to parents of soldiers, etc

SECTION 2. This act is to take effect from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 422.

AN ACT requiring reports and the payment of annual license fees by corporations, companies and persons operating or controlling dams, booms, sluice-ways or other structures under the authority of any general or special law of this state, in navigable streams or waters, situated within or forming a part of the boundary line of this state.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Every corporation, company or person operating or controlling in whole or in part, any dam, boom, sluice-way or other struc-
