SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 460.

AN ACT to amend section 9, of chapter 374, of the laws of 1887, entitled, "An act to secure the better preservation of game."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 9, of chapter 374, of the laws of 1887, is hereby amended by striking out the word "mink," so that said section when amended shall read as follows: Section 9. It shall be unlawful to take, catch, kill or destroy, or have in possession when so killed or taken, any otter, marten or fisher, between the first day of May and the succeeding first day of November.

Amends chapter 374, laws of 1887.

Closed season.
