The style of all ordinances shall be: "The common council of the city of West Bend do ordain," etc. A majority of the members of the common council shall constitute a quorum, but a less number may adjourn from time to time.

Repeals sec. 35, chapter 99, laws of 1885. SECTION 4. Section 35, of said act to be stricken out and expunged entirely.

Amends sec. 37, of chapter 99, laws of 1885. SECTION 5 Section 37, of said act, is hereby amended by striking out all of subdivision 35, of said section 37, relating to the appointment of a street commissioner.

## CHAPTER 57.

AN ACT to amend the charter of the city of Tomah, Monroe county, Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Amends chapter 134, laws of 1883.

Section 1, Section 61, of chapter 134, of the laws of 1883, entitled, "An act to incorporate the city of Tomah," and amendment thereto, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following: The territory embraced within said city limits, and the scuthwest quarter of the northeast quarter of section thirty-three in said township eighteen north, of range one west, and the east half of section five, the north half of the northeast quarter of section eight, and the north half of section ten, township seventeen north, of range one west, and the inhabitants thereof, are hereby attached to and shall hereafter constitute a part of school district number one of the city of Tomah, for all school purposes, and the inhabitants of such territory so attached, shall have all the rights and privileges of residents of said school district in the schools and school meetings, of said school district number one of the

city of Tomah, and the general laws relating to joint school districts between towns, and regulating the levy and collection of school taxes upon the territory so attached, and the inhabitants thereof, and the payment thereof to the treasurer of said school district number one, of the city of Tomah, shall apply to and govern the towns of La Grange and Tomah, in their relations to said school district number one, of the city of Tomah, so that said section when so amended, shall read as follows: Section 61. The common schools of the city of Tomah shall Common schools to be be under the control and supervision of the under control school district board of each district in the same and supervismanner as if this act had not passed, and the board. same relations shall be sustained between said city and such schools, as near as may be, as between towns and school districts therein, and the same reciprocal powers and duties, and until otherwise provided by the common council of said city. The territory embraced within said city limits, and the inhabitants thereof, shall constitute one school district, to be known as school district number one of the city of Tomah. The officers of school district number one of the town of Tomah shall be the officers of said school district number one of the city of Tomah during their unexpired term and until their successors are elected and qualified in accordance with the laws of the state of Wisconsin, regulating school districts, and all real estate and personal property belonging to school district number one, of the town of Tomah, is hereby vested in school district number one of the city of Tomah, and the territory embraced within said city limits, and the southwest quarter of the northeast quarter of section thirty-three, in said township eighteen north, of range one west, and the east half of section five, the north half of the north-east quarter of section eight and the north half of section ten, township seventeen north, of range one west, and the inhabitants thereof, are hereby attached to and shall hereafter constitute a part of school district number one, of the city of Tomah, for all school purposes, and the inhabitants of such territory so attached, shall have all the rights and privileges of residents of said

school district, in the schools and school meetings of said district number one, of the city of Tomah, and the general laws relating to joint school districts between towns and regulating the levy and collection of school taxes upon the territory so attached and the inhabitants thereof and the payment thereof to the treasurer of said school district number one of the city of Tomah, shall apply to and govern the towns of La Grange and Tomah, in their relations to said school district number one of the city of Tomah.

SECTION 2. All acts and parts of acts in conflict with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 58.

AN ACT to incorporate the city of Tomahawk.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

## CHAPTER I.

City incorporated. SECTION 1. All that territory in section two, of this chapter described, situate in the county of Lincoln, shall be a city by the name of Tomahawk, and the people now inhabiting and those who shall inhabit said district shall be a municipal corporation by the name of Tomahawk, and shall have the general powers hereafter specifically granted, and the authorities thereof shall have perpetual succession and shall be capable of contracting and being contracted with, suing and being sued, pleading and being impleaded in all courts of law and equity, and shall have a common seal, and may change and alter the same at pleasure.
