CHAPTER 82.

AN ACT to amend chapter 450 of the laws of 1889, entitled "An act relating to and fixing the corporate limits of the city of Milwaukee," approved April 16, 1889.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 450 of the laws of 1889, entitled, "An act relating to and fixing the corporate limits of the city of Milwaukee," approved April 16, 1889, is hereby amended by striking out the proviso of said section and inserting in lieu thereof the following: Provided, and it is hereby enacted, that that portion of the property hereinbefore described known as Cold Spring Driving Park, be exempt from taxation and from any and all special taxes and assessments for the year 1891, so long as the same shall be leased, used or occupied during said year, by the Wisconsin State Agricultural Society for the purpose of holding the annual State Fair.

Amend section 1, chapter 450, laws of 1889.

Cold Spring Driving Park exempt from taxation for 1891, conditionally.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
