CHAPTER 202.

AN ACT to provide for notice of action in certain cases.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. No action against any railroad or railway corporation for damages to property occasioned by fire set from a locomotive, or for stock killed or injured by such corporation, shall be maintained, unless within one year after the happening of the event causing such damage, notice in writing signed by the party owning such property or stock, his agent or attorney, shall be given to such corporation against which damage is claimed, stating the time and place where such damage occurred, and that satisfaction therefor is claimed of such corporation. Such notice may be given in the manner required for the service of summons in courts of record.

Damages from fire set by locomotive, etc.; notice to be given within one year.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 203.

AN ACT to authorize James Spaulding, his heirs and assigns, to build and maintain dams across Comet river, in the counties of Shawano and Waupaca, in the state of Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. For the purpose of improving the navigation of the Comet river, James Spaulding, his heirs or assigns, are hereby authorized to
