## CHAPTER 212.

AN ACT appropriating to Peter G. Rademacher a sum of money therein named, to defray expenses of election contest.

*The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

Appropriation  
to Peter G.  
Rademacher.

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to Peter G. Rademacher, out of any moneys in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of six hundred and seventy-four dollars and seventy-two cents, to defray the expenses of his contest for the office of member of assembly for the Tenth assembly district of the county of Milwaukee.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 213.

AN ACT to amend section 1, of chapter 38, of the private and local laws of 1872, entitled "An act to authorize Reuben C. Lyon to erect and maintain a dam across the Wisconsin river."

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 1, of chapter 38, of the private and local laws of 1872, entitled "An act to authorize Reuben C. Lyon to erect and maintain a dam across the Wisconsin river," is hereby amended by striking out the word "four," at the end of line seven in said section, and inserting in lieu thereof the word "ten," so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows: Section
