CHAPTER 216.

AN ACT to appropriate to Theodore Prochnow a sum of money for expenses incurred by him in contesting his right to the seat of member of assembly for the Tenth district in Milwaukee county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

**Appropriation
to Theodore
Prochnow.**

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to Theodore Prochnow out of any moneys in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of nine hundred and fifty-four dollars and fifty cents, in full for expenses incurred by him in contesting for the seat of member of the assembly for the Tenth district in Milwaukee county.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 217.

AN ACT to appropriate to George H. Wunderlich a sum of money therein named.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

**Appropriation
to George H.
Wunderlich.**

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to George H. Wunderlich, out of any moneys in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of seven hundred and forty-nine dollars and fifty-one cents, in full for expenses incurred by him in contesting for the office of member of assem-
