## CHAPTER 267.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money sufficient to carry out the provisions of joint resolution number 38 A, relating to the furnishing of copies of Sanborn and Berryman's Annotated Statutes to persons therein named.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the treasury, not otherwise appropriated, a sum sufficient to carry out the provisions of joint resolution number 38 A, of the session of the legislature for 1893, which said resolution requires the superintendent of public property to furnish assemblymen Jennings, Parkinson, and Peterson, under joint resolution number 57 A, each, with a copy of Sanborn and Berryman's Annotated Statutes.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 268.

AN ACT relating to actions upon official bonds.
