CHAPTER 299.

AN ACT to appropriate a certain sum of money therein named.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Appropriation
for purchase of
five copies of
S. & B's Anno.
Stats.

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated from the treasury, out of any moneys not otherwise appropriated, the sum of sixty-two dollars and fifty cents for the purpose of purchasing five copies of Sanborn and Berryman's Annotated Statutes, in accordance with joint resolution number 69 A.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 300.

AN ACT relating to the compensation of the officiating chaplains of the senate and assembly.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Appropriation
for officiating
chaplains of
legislature.

SECTION 1. The sum of fifteen dollars is hereby authorized to be paid to each and every clergyman, who has officiated or may hereafter officiate as chaplain of the senate and assembly, for each week of such service, during the session of the legislature for the year 1893; but no payment shall be made for less than four days' service, and only upon the certificate of the chief clerk of the assembly or senate, showing the amount to which each such chaplain is entitled.
