CHAPTER 30.

AN ACT to amend section 3807, of the Revised Statutes of Wisconsin for 1878, relating to letters of administration and administrators.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 3807, of the Revised Statutes of Wisconsin for 1878, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following subdivision:

Amends sec. 3807, R. S.

4. If there be no application for administration by the widow, or next of kin, or any creditor, for sixty days after the death of any person, then any one in whose favor a cause of action exists, which cannot be maintained without the appointment of an administrator of such deceased person, may apply for and obtain the appointment of an administrator, upon such showing, by petition, to the county court.
