CHAPTER 304.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money for the purchase of desks and chairs for the assembly chamber and desks for the senate chamber.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Appropriation
for purchase of
desks and
chairs.

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the general fund not otherwise appropriated, a sum not exceeding six thousand dollars, for the purchase of desks and chairs for the assembly chamber, and desks for the senate chamber.

SECTION 12. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 305.

AN ACT to amend section 3, chapter 315, of the laws of 1885, entitled "An act in relation to the instruction of deaf mutes."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 3, of chapter 315, laws of 1885, is hereby amended so as to read as follows:
Section 3. There shall be paid out of the state treasury in the month of July, in each year, to the treasurer of every incorporated city or village maintaining a school or schools for the instruction of deaf mutes under the charge of one or more teachers of approved qualifications, to be ascertained by the state superintendent of

public instruction, the sum of one hundred twenty-five dollars for each deaf mute pupil instructed in any such school at least nine months during the year next preceding the first day of July, and a share of such sum proportionate to the term of instruction of any such pupil, as shall be so instructed less than nine months during the year.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication

CHAPTER 306.

AN ACT defining the duties of the district attorney of Dunn county in certain cases, and amendatory of chapter 448, laws of 1891, relating to providing for placing fishways in dams in Dunn county, the charters of which require the construction of such fishways.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 448, laws of 1891, is hereby amended by adding at the end of section 3 the following: "It is hereby made the duty of the district attorney of Dunn county, to prosecute for penalties, under the provisions of this act, when directed by the commissioners of fisheries so to do, upon the complaint of either of said commissioners, or of any citizen of Dunn county."
