CHAPTER 49.

AN ACT to authorize the county of Dunn to build, equip and maintain a free ferry across the Chippewa river, within the limits of Dunn county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The county of Dunn and its successors and assigns, is hereby authorized to build, equip and maintain a free ferry across the Chippewa river within the limits of said county. May maintain free ferry.

SECTION 2. The county board of supervisors of said county is hereby authorized to provide for the building, equipping and maintaining of such ferry.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 50.

AN ACT to authorize Carl Kleinschmidt and his assigns to build and maintain a dam on Devil creek.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Carl Kleinschmidt and his assigns are hereby authorized and empowered to erect, keep up and maintain a dam across Devil creek, in Lincoln county, at the following point, to-wit: On the east half of the northeast quarter of section twenty, in township thirty-one north, range six east, for the purpose of facilitating the driving of logs and of creating a mill-pond. Location of dam.
