CHAPTER 54.

AN ACT authorizing the State Historical Society of Wisconsin to sell and convey certain real estate.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

May sell certain real estate in city of Madison.

SECTION 1. The State Historical Society of Wisconsin is hereby authorized to sell and convey certain real estate on West Washington avenue, city of Madison, known as "the Draper homestead," being lot number four, block number fifty-one, according to the recorded plat of said city, and the buildings thereon. The proceeds from such sale shall go to said society's binding fund.

Deed, how executed.

SECTION 2. Whenever the executive committee of said society shall sell said real estate, the deed or conveyance thereof shall be signed by the president and corresponding secretary, attested by the recording secretary, with the seal of the society affixed thereto, and shall be acknowledged before some proper officer authorized to take the acknowledgment of deeds.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
