CHAPTER 82.

AN ACT to authorize turnpike and plank road corporations, organized under general laws, to purchase roads constructed under private charters.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Any corporation, now or hereafter organized under general laws of this state for the purpose of constructing and owning a turnpike or plank road, may purchase from any turnpike or plank road company, acting under a private charter, or from the purchaser of the rights and property of any such corporation at judicial, trustee or mortgage sale, the roadbed, superstructure, right of way, toll houses and other property owned by said corporation or their legal successors. May purchase private roads.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 83.

AN ACT to authorize the governor to appoint a board of commissioners by the name and style of "Commissioners for the Promotion of Uniformity of Legislation in the United States."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Within thirty days after the passage of this act, the governor shall appoint three commissioners, who are hereby constituted a Commissioners, how appointed, j duties.
