CHAPTER 98.

AN ACT relating to the chronic insane and amendatory of section 604n, of chapter 32, of Sanborn and Berryman's Annotated Statutes of Wisconsin, relating to state laws applicable to county asylums.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 604n. of Sanborn and Berryman's Annotated Statutes of this state, is hereby amended by adding the following subdivision thereto, after subdivision 14, on page 379. of said statutes: Subdivision 15. The several county boards of supervisors in this state shall have the power to create an asylum fund, which shall be created with all sums of money received from the state and from other counties for the care of insane and all other revenue derived from whatever source, together with such appropriations for the asylum as may be made from time to time by the county board, and shall be chargeable with all sums paid out for or on account of said asylum.
