JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 12.

Relating to employes in legislature.

Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring: That the chairman of assembly committee on Railroads, Incorporations, Town and County Organizations, and the committee on State Affairs, are hereby authorized and empowered to each employ a clerk for their several committees, who shall each receive the same compensation as the clerks of the committee on Judiciary and on Claims.

Resolved further. That four committee room attendants be authorized to be appointed by the several chairmen of the committees named, who shall severally receive the same compensation as committee room attendants already authorized.

Resolved further. That the sergeant-at-arms be authorized to employ an assembly night laborer, and one additional messenger boy, whose compensation shall be two dollars per day, respectively.

JOINT RESOLUTION NO 13.

Resolution of the committee on Insurance, Banks, and Banking, to employ a clerk for said committee.

Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring: That the chairman of the assembly committee on Insurance, Banks, and Banking is hereby authorized and empowered to employ a clerk for said committee, who shall also act as room attendant, and who shall receive the same compensation, as that paid other committee clerks.
