CHAPTER 144.

AN ACT legalizing the acts of the county board of Florence county, and an ordinance passed by them relating to the division of the town of Commonwealth, and creating the town of Homestead.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The acts of the county board of supervisors of the county of Florence, state of Wisconsin, in passing an ordinance on the twenty-fourth day of February, 1894, dividing the town of Commonwealth and creating the town of Homestead therein, are hereby legalized and made valid.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
