All jurors summoned and attending such county courts shall receive two dollars per day, and one dollar for each half day's attendance; and six cents per mile for each mile actually traveled in going and returning by the most usual route, but shall be paid for no day when court is not in session, unless specially ordered by the presiding judge to be paid out of the county treasury upon like certificates as jurors in circuit courts are paid.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 148.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to the Wisconsin State Horticultural Society.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated the sum of fifteen hundred dollars out of the general fund annually to the Wisconsin State Horticultural society, and five hundred dollars to establish an additional experiment station.

\$1,500 appropriated annually.

SECTION 2. Chapter 117, of the laws of 1893, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
