CHAPTER 343.

AN ACT amending section 375, revised statutes of 1878, in relation to binding for the State Historical Society.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. That portion of section 375, of the revised statutes of 1878, as amended by chapter 106, of the laws of 1880, which relates to binding for the State Historical Society is hereby amended to read as follows: The secretary of state shall cause the state printer to bind, in half calf binding, the British patent reports, and in suitable binding all newspaper files, and other periodicals which the society, as the trustee of the state, shall hereafter receive; and said printer shall, on order of the secretary of state, print such circulars, blanks and labels as the corresponding secretary of said society may require in the conduct of the society's business. The secretary of state is directed to audit the same, and for these purposes a sufficient amount is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
