

twenty thousand dollars shall be annually returned to the general fund.

SECTION 3. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this act, the secretary of state and state treasurer, with the consent and approval of the governor, are hereby authorized and empowered to transfer from the trust funds of the state to the general fund the sum of seventy-two thousand five hundred dollars, to be returned to the trust funds from the general fund income for the fiscal year ending on the 30th day of September, 1896.

\$72,500 authorized to be transferred to the general fund.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 92.

AN ACT to appropriate money to pay the additional employes of the legislature of 1895.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, a sum sufficient to pay the additional employes of the legislature of 1895, as provided for in joint resolutions of the two houses; provided, that the attendant for the committee on judiciary in the senate shall receive pay from the commencement of the session.

Appropriation for additional employes of the legislature.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
