CHAPTER 137.

AN ACT to amend section 1, of chapter 50, of the laws of 1889, relating to the terms of court in the second judicial circuit.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1, of chapter 50, of the laws of Wisconsin, passed in the year 1889, entitled, "An act to change the time of holding court in the second judicial circuit, and to regulate the noticing of actions, for trial therein," is hereby amended so as to read as follows: "Section 1. The terms of the circuit court for the county of Milwaukee, in the second judicial circuit, shall be held on the first Mondays of January, April, July and October in each year. A jury shall be summoned for the first day of each of said terms unless otherwise ordered by the court."

Time of holding court in second judicial district changed.

Terms of court fixed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after the first day of April, A. D. 1897.
