CHAPTER 206.

AN ACT to authorize J. F. Hamilton, Charles T. Baker and Horace Miner, their associates, heirs and assigns, to build and maintain a dam across Beaver creek, in the county of Juneau, Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Authority to construct a dam across Beaver creek in Juneau county.

SECTION 1. J. F. Hamilton, Charles T. Baker and Horace Miner, their associates, heirs and assigns, are hereby authorized to build and maintain a dam across Beaver creek, on section number thirty-three, in township number nineteen north, of range number two east, in the county of Juneau, Wisconsin; said dam, however, not to exceed twelve feet in height from the bed of the stream. The legislature hereby reserves the right to alter, amend or repeal this act.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
