CHAPTER 3.

AN ACT to appropriate money for the purchase of stationery for the use of the state.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the general fund not otherwise appropriated, the sum of ten thousand dollars, for the purchase of stationery for the use of state officers and departments, for the years 1897 and 1898, and for the legislative session of 1899, said sum being the amount estimated to be necessary for the purpose specified.

\$10,000 appropriated for stationery for 1897-8.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
