CHAPTER 373.

AN ACT authorizing cities of the first, second and third class, whether operating under general or special charter, to license and regulate department stores.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. All cities of the first, second and third classes within this state, whether operating under general or special charters, are hereby authorized and empowered to license and regulate department stores therein.
