## CHAPTER 60.

AN ACT relating to the salary of the county judge of Kewaunee county.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

Salary of  
county judge  
to be \$1,000.

SECTION 1. For the term beginning the first Monday in January, A. D. 1898, and thereafter, until fixed by the county board of Kewaunee county, according to law, the salary of the county judge of the county of Kewaunee shall be one thousand dollars per annum, payable in monthly instalments at the end of each month, out of the treasury of said county; such salary shall be in full for all official services as county judge; and the county judge shall report to and pay over to the county treasurer all fees for transcripts of records and certified copies of papers.

SECTION 2. All acts, or parts of acts, as far as the same are in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
