CHAPTER 65.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to persons therein named, for expenses incurred as legislative visiting committee to state institutions.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Appropriation for the legislative visiting committee, \$300.

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, for expenses incurred as visiting committee of the legislature for 1896 and 1897 to state institutions, to W. D. Woodworth, W. T. Lewis and Thos. J. McGrath, the sum of one hundred dollars each.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
