No compensation whatever shall be paid or allowed any director; provided, that in any city or village which has established or may establish a free library under the provisions of section 931, that the city superintendent of schools, or the supervising principal of schools shall be ex-officio a member of the board of directors of such library.

CHAPTER 93.

AN ACT to provide for the assessment for street improvements, sewers and water pipes of lands in cities owned or used by cemetery associations.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. All lands owned or used within the limits of any city of the first or second class by any corporation, society or association now or hereafter owning or using such lands for cemetery or burial purposes, shall be subject to all special assessments for the improvement of streets, or construction of sewers and the laying of water pipes in front of or adjoining the same, in the same manner as other lands abutting on such streets.

Lands that are subject to special assessments.

SECTION 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
