## CHAPTER 99.

AN ACT relating to the printing of the proceedings of the state conference of charities and corrections, and to amend section 5, chapter 526, laws of 1889.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 5, of chapter 526, laws of 1889, entitled, "An act to provide for and regulate the printing, binding and distribution of the reports of state officers, departments, institutions and societies," is amended by adding thereto the following: Two thousand copies of the transactions of the state conference of charities and corrections. Five hundred copies to be bound in Wisconsin public documents, pursuant to chapter 263, of the laws of 1895, five hundred copies to be bound in cloth, and the remaining one thousand copies in pamphlet form; provided, that the whole number of printed pages shall not exceed two hundred and fifty, to be distributed by the state board of control and the president and secretary of the conference acting with it. The provisions of the next succeeding section of chapter 526, laws of 1889, (section 6) shall not apply to such distribution.

Number and size of report. 2,000 copies to be printed biennially.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
