CHAPTER 15.

AN ACT authorizing and directing the overhauling of the public closets in the capitol building, and the renewing of the plumbing therein, and making an appropriation therefor.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Superintendent of public property to conduct improvements.

SECTION 1. The superintendent of public property is hereby authorized and directed, by and with the advice of the governor, to overhaul the public closets in the capitol building and renew the plumbing therein.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the general fund, not otherwise appropriated, a sufficient amount of money to carry out the purposes of this act, not exceeding the sum of two thousand dollars.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
