

SECTION 2. Each of the said assistant factory inspectors shall be paid a salary at the rate of one thousand dollars per annum together with necessary traveling expenses to be paid out of money in the general fund not otherwise appropriated. Salaries of.

SECTION 3. All acts and parts of acts conflicting with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 153.

AN ACT to provide compensation for the officiating chaplains of the senate and assembly for the session of 1899.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to each and every clergyman who has or may hereafter officiate as chaplain of the senate and assembly the sum of fifteen dollars for each week of such service during the sessions of the legislature for the year 1899. The payments shall be made upon the certificates of the chief clerks of the senate and assembly showing the amount to which each such chaplain is entitled. Fifteen dollars for each week's service appropriated.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
