CHAPTER 187.

AN ACT to appropriate to Michael Gleason a certain sum of money.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to Michael Gleason the sum of thirteen hundred seven dollars and sixteen cents, on account of materials furnished and labor performed by the said Michael Gleason in and upon the erection and completion of the heating, lighting and power plant for the state of Wisconsin, located on the grounds of the Wisconsin Industrial School for Boys, at Waukesha, Wisconsin.

SECTION 2. The sum of money mentioned in section 1 of this act shall be paid to the said Michael Gleason for the materials so furnished by him and for the labor so performed by him, on bills therefor to be audited by the secretary of state only upon the sworn statement of such creditor that the sum claimed by him is for materials actually furnished and labor actually performed in the construction of said plant, and that the sum claimed therefor is just and true.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
