CHAPTER 293.

AN ACT to set aside certain state land to the Wisconsin military reservation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Forty acres
set aside.

SECTION 1. The commissioners of the public lands are hereby authorized and directed to withdraw from sale the northwest quarter of the north-east quarter of section twenty-one (21), township seventeen (17), north, of range two (2), east, and to set aside said land for the perpetual use of the Wisconsin military reservation.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
