CHAPTER 44.

AN ACT to pay the Sturgeon Bay Bridge Company a sum of money therein named.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There shall be paid by the treasurer of the state of Wisconsin, from any public moneys not otherwise appropriated, to the Sturgeon Bay Bridge Company, the sum of one hundred twenty-six dollars and seventy-five cents, which amount is due the said bridge company from the state by reason of the payment of taxes to the state which should have been paid to the city of Sturgeon Bay.

Return of taxes paid to state instead of to Sturgeon Bay.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force, from and after its passage and publication.
