**CHAPTER 62.**

AN ACT to amend section 2424 of the Wisconsin statutes of 1898, relating to the terms of court in the seventeenth judicial circuit.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 2424 of the Wisconsin statutes of 1898 is hereby amended by striking out the words, "and on the second Monday of December" in the third and fourth lines of that part of said section relating to terms of court in the seventeenth judicial circuit, so that said part of said section when amended will read as follows: seventeenth circuit. In the county of Jackson on the first Monday in March and September; in the county of Eau Claire on the third Monday in March and September; in the county of Clark on the third Monday in April and October. There shall also be held in the county of Eau Claire, on the second Monday in June, a special term for said circuit, but no jury shall be drawn for said term.

SECTION 2. All acts and parts of acts, conflicting with this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force, from and after its passage and publication.
