CHAPTER 75.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to George F. Peabody by reason of invalidity of chapter 221, laws of 1895.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to George F. Peabody, of Appleton, Wisconsin, the sum of four hundred sixteen dollars and eighty-four cents, to reimburse the said Peabody for a judgment obtained against him by C. W. Streckenbach & Co., of Green Bay, for fish belonging to the said Streckenbach & Co., seized by the said Peabody under the provisions of chapter 221, laws of 1895, which said chapter 221, laws of 1895, was afterwards held invalid by the supreme court of the state of Wisconsin.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
