

twenty-five dollars nor more than one hundred dollars for each such violation of the provisions of this act in addition to all costs of suit, the same to be recovered in a civil action brought in the name of the state of Wisconsin by the state fish and game warden or one of his deputies.

Conflicting laws repealed. SECTION 6. All laws, acts or parts of acts in conflict or inconsistent with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force, from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 129.

AN ACT to amend section 3223 of Wisconsin statutes of 1898, relating to the enforcement of liabilities against officers and stockholders of corporations.

The people of the state of Wisconsin represented in senate and assembly do enact as follows:

Remedies given not to be construed as exclusive. SECTION 1. Section 3223 of the Wisconsin statutes of 1898 is hereby amended by adding to the end thereof the following: Provided that no remedy given in this chapter shall be construed to be exclusive, so as to preclude the enforcement of any liability herein mentioned in an additional action or actions if there are parties or property that can not be reached by the first action or judgment.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force, from and after its passage and publication.
