## CHAPTER 291.

AN ACT to appropriate a certain sum of money to pay the salary of George R. Whitman, as agent of the state board of immigration, due at the time of his death.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin represented in senate and assembly do enact as follows:*

**Appropriation.** SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of seventy-nine dollars to pay the personal representative of George R. Whitman, deceased, such salary as may have been due him as agent of the state board of immigration at the time of his death.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 292.

AN ACT to authorize Angus J. McGilvray, his heirs, associates and assigns to build and maintain a dam across the Flambeau river in Chippewa county, Wisconsin.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin represented in senate and assembly do enact as follows:*

**Location of dam; log slides; height of.** SECTION 1. Angus J. McGilvray of Chippewa Falls, Wisconsin, his heirs, associates and assigns, are hereby authorized to build and maintain a dam across the Flambeau river in Chippewa county, state of Wisconsin, at any point he or they may select, on section thirty-five in township thirty-six north, of range five west, and to use the water of said river for the purpose of operating any and all
