CHAPTER 316.

AN ACT to prescribe the duties of city superintendent of schools in cities of the third and fourth class.

The people of the state of Wisconsin represented in senate and assembly do enact as follows:

To examine and license teachers. SECTION 1. It shall be the duty of the city superintendent of schools, in those cities of the third and fourth class in which the office of city superintendent of schools has been created or may hereafter be created by the common council thereof under the provisions of section 925—23 of the statutes of 1898, to examine and license teachers, and under the direction of the board of education to supervise and manage the schools.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 317.

AN ACT to amend section 3023q, statutes of 1898 relating to the duties of the bank examiner.

The people of the state of Wisconsin represented in senate and assembly do enact as follows:

Powers over insolvent bank. SECTION 1. Section 2023q, statutes of 1898, is hereby amended by striking out all after the word "appearing" where it occurs in the sixth line of said section and inserting in lieu thereof the following: "If any bank shall refuse or neglect for ninety days after receipt of such notice to make good such deficiency and shall refuse to go into liquidation, the bank examiner may notify the attorney general
