

who shall thereupon institute proceedings for the appointment of a receiver to close up the business of such bank. Whenever the bank examiner, after due examination of its affairs, shall become satisfied that a bank is insolvent, he may immediately take charge of such bank and all the property and effects thereof and notify the attorney general of his action therein; and it is hereby made the duty of the attorney general, upon receiving such notice, to immediately institute proper proceedings for the purpose of having a receiver appointed to take charge of such bank and wind up the affairs and business thereof."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 318.

AN ACT to amend section 1363 of the statutes of 1898, relating to town drains.

The people of the state of Wisconsin represented in senate and assembly do enact as follows:

Straightening or altering course of drains. SECTION 1. That section 1363 of the statutes of 1898 is hereby amended by inserting after the word "may" in the thirty-third line of said section, the following words, to-wit: "straighten or alter the course or," and also by inserting after the word "sloping" in the thirty-fifth line of said section, the following words, to-wit: "straightening or altering the course of."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
