CHAPTER 325.

AN ACT to regulate the taking of fish in certain waters in Fond du Lac county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin represented in senate and assembly do enact as follows:

Prohibited methods of taking. SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, catch or kill any fish in the waters of Wolf lake, Giltner lake or Long Lake and streams connected with said lakes in Fond du Lac county, by the use of any traps, spear, net or other device except hook and line.

Closed season. SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful to take, catch or kill or attempt so to do, any fish of any variety from waters mentioned in this act, between the fifteenth day of March and the fifteenth day of the following May of each year.

Penalty for violations. SECTION 3. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this act shall, on conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not less than five dollars nor more than ten dollars or by imprisonment in the county jail not more than twenty days.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force, from and after its passage and publication.
