CHAPTER 447.

AN ACT to correct a mistake in chapter 197 of the laws of 1901, relating to the binding of periodicals of the Wisconsin Academy of Sciences, Arts and Letters.

The people of the state of Wisconsin represented in senate and assembly do enact as follows:

Appropriation made annual. SECTION 1. Chapter 197 of the laws of 1901, is hereby amended by adding after the word "dollars" in the third line from the bottom of section 1, as printed in the official paper, the words "per annum," so that said chapter, when so amended, shall read as follows: Section 1. Section 341 of the revised statutes of 1898, is hereby amended by adding thereto, the following: "The secretary of state may authorize the state printer to bind in suitable binding all periodicals and other exchanges which the society shall hereafter receive, at a cost not exceeding one hundred and fifty dollars, per annum. The secretary of state shall audit the accounts for such binding."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
