CHAPTER 99.**AN ACT** relating to the county court of Rock county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin represented in senate and assembly do enact as follows:

When county judge may request municipal judge to sit. SECTION 1. In case of the sickness, absence from home or inability arising from any cause, of the county judge of Rock county, or in case said judge, or any member of his family, or any relative is in any way interested in any proceeding in the Rock county court, or before the judge of said court, or when said judge deems that for any cause it is improper for him to hear or try any proceeding in said court or before him as judge of said court, he may request the municipal judge of said county to hold said court or hear and try any such matter or proceeding; and the said municipal judge is hereby authorized and empowered upon such request from the county judge to hold said county court, or perform any act as judge thereof as fully as said county judge is authorized or empowered to do.

Designation of judge called in. SECTION 2. Such municipal judge when acting under request of the county judge as provided in section 1 of this act shall be designated as "acting county judge."

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
