JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 12.

Providing for an amendment of section 23, article IV of the constitution and for separate county government in certain counties.

RESOLVED by the senate, the assembly concurring, that section 23, of article IV, of the constitution of the state of Wisconsin, be amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

“Provided that in counties which contain an incorporated city of more than one hundred thousand inhabitants, the legislature may establish a separate system of county government” so that when so amended said section will read as follows: “Section 23. The legislature shall establish but one system of town and county government, which shall be as nearly uniform as practicable; provided, that in counties which contain an incorporated city of more than one hundred thousand inhabitants, the legislature may establish a separate system of county government.
