CHAPTER 246.**AN ACT to give certain powers to city truancy officers.**

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Powers of truant officers. SECTION 1. Any truant officer within this state shall have power to visit factories, workshops, mercantile establishments and other places of employment in their respective localities and ascertain whether any minors are employed therein contrary to law. They may require that the age and school certificates and lists of minors who are employed in such factories, workshops, mercantile establishments and other places of employment, shall be produced for their inspection, and they shall report all cases of such illegal employment to the school authorities of their respective cities, towns, villages or districts and to the commissioner of labor, state factory inspector or any assistant factory inspector. Such truant officer shall receive no compensation from the state for performing such services.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
