CHAPTER 387.

AN ACT relating to assessments and tax levies made by the state board of assessment and making appropriation of the moneys collected by such levies.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Taxes, how available. SECTION 1. All taxes heretofore collected and paid into the general fund of the state treasury in pursuance of any assessment and levy made by the state board of assessment shall be available for and shall be used for the payment of the general expenses of the state and of the general expenses of the several state institutions, and any appropriation or use heretofore made for such purposes of any tax thus assessed and levied is hereby ratified and confirmed.

Taxes, how to be used. SECTION 2. Any and all taxes hereafter collected in pursuance of any assessment and levy made by the state board of assessment and paid into the general fund of the state treasury, shall be used to pay the general expenses of the state and the general expenses of the several state institutions, and any money in the general fund thus collected is hereby appropriated and made available for such use and purposes.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
