CHAPTER 462.

AN ACT to provide compensation for the officiating chaplains of the senate and assembly for the session of 1905, and making an appropriation therefor.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Compensation per week. SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to each and every clergyman who has or may hereafter officiate as chaplain of the senate and assembly, the sum of three dollars for each day of such service during the session of the legislature for the year 1905. The payments shall be made upon the certificates of the chief clerks of the senate and assembly showing the amount to which each such chaplain is entitled.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
