CHAPTER 484.

AN ACT to provide for the location, erection and construction of two additional fish hatcheries, and making an appropriation therefor.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Additional fish hatcheries authorized. SECTION 1. The commissioners of fisheries are hereby directed to locate, erect, construct and equip a fish hatchery for the propagation of bass fry at a point to be selected by them as most suitable in the lake region in the southeastern part of the state, and to locate, erect, construct and equip a fish hatchery for the propagation of trout fry at a point in the western part of the state to be selected by them as most suitable.

Appropriation. SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated from the hunting license fund the sum of ten thousand dollars, to be used for the purchase of a site and the erection, construction and equipment of the said hatchery for bass fry, to be available on the first day of November, 1905; and there is hereby appropriated from the hunting license fund the sum of five thousand dollars to be used for the purchase of a site and the erection, construction and equipment of said hatchery for trout fry, to be available on the first day of November, 1906.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
